NCE Mandate

What are we offering?

To make concrete our efforts in achieving our mandate, we offer adult formation which will assist people in the fulfillment of their baptismal promise of sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ. Such formation can be practical, spiritual or academic. We are conscious that many dioceses have the means to conduct such formation themselves. The NCE is happy to assist them, but our primary focus is to reach out to those pockets within the Catholic Church in Australia where these opportunities are limited.

What topics we can offer

Our team specialises in developing tailor made spiritual and practical formation on the following topics:

What formats we can offer

- Seminar input by the facilitator, but time for questions and discussion

Spiritual, practical or both?

When thinking of engaging in adult faith formation, consideration should be given to whether the focus of the formation should be spiritual, practical, academic or a combination of each. It is very important for the organisers to be very clear about what they are trying to achieve. Do your attendees need some practical help in establishing a parish team or the like? Or, do your attendees need a spiritual experience in which they can encounter Christ in a prayerful and reflective way, and thus be re-energised to undertake their ministries? Or, are they requiring some accessible input on aspects of Catholic faith and practice?

Our team can assist you in the planning. Our aim is to ensure that your needs are met in the most practical, but meaningful way.

What does this cost?

We are very much aware that many parishes do not have huge financial resources. When establishing the cost we propose the following:

- \$40 per hour per facilitator
- Cover the costs of the facilitator's travel, accommodation and meals

We realise that even the above might be too much, especially for remote places where travel expenses can be high. However, don't let this prevent you from making contact with us. As they say, we'll work something out!
